# KELOWNA CURLING CLUB

Minutes of the Annual General Meeting (AGM) held Wednesday October 5, 2016 in the Lounge of the Kelowna Curling Club

Club President Brendan Willis welcomed those attending. With 39 members present, the meeting was called to order at 7:12pm

## AGENDA:

Copies of the agenda were distributed and a motion to accept the agenda as distributed was moved by George Mapson and seconded by Peter Ellison. The motion was carried.

## MINUTES:

The minutes of last year's AGM of October 1, 2015 were distributed. A motion to accept them was made by Ken Mair and seconded by Ray Tait. The motion was carried.

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

President Brendan Willis provided a report for the past year. A lot of good things happened this year. Good growth in membership, pro-shop sales, and finances. Some new expenses as well.

CIS tournament, lots of unbelievable feedback and the club showed well to visiting clubs.

The Kelowna Curling Club has paid off approximately \$90,000 of various loans, including two private loans and a large amount of the loan from the City of Kelowna; about \$120,000 is still remaining. We are also saving to spend on new chairs and other building items including a new roof.

## FINANCE:

Interim Treasurer Ken Mair distributed the financial statements for the fiscal year ended April 30, 2016.

## QUESTIONS FROM THE FLOOR

- Where does the sponsorship money go?

All sign revenues goes under other operations also locker rentals, sign rentals and goes into general revenue.

- Question about City of Kelowna loan, how much do we pay on each payment dates?

\$20,000 is the semi-annual amount that we pay each time.

A motion to accept the 2016 financial statements was moved by Jake Thiessen and seconded by Rory Nugent. The motion was carried.
