General Guidelines:

Masks are requested on and off the ice at the Kelowna Curling Club. The only exception is when eating, drinking or sweeping. Spectators are allowed in the building, one per team and must stay in seat upstairs behind assigned sheet.

**If you feel sick in any way, including shortness of breath, fever, cough or sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, or any members of your household do. Please stay home**

All common/high touch area (tables, chairs, door handles, faucets, handles, toilet seats, cash register/card reader) will be sanitized after every draw/rental.

Contactless payment by Credit card, debit and e-transfer is preferred.

The Board of Directors or the General Manager may modify these requirements at any time.

Prior to your draw please enter through the front door and unless coming for a meal or drinks arrive no more than 15 minutes before your drawtime. When you enter please sanitize your hands, take your temperature and sign in. Please follow the arrow on the floor and use the correct door for you ice assignment.

Lockerrooms will only be used for storing your equipment, please get your shoes and brooms and then proceed out to behind your sheet (unless there is already a game on). No more than 3 person in the lockerroom at a time.

Please arrive with your curling clothes on.

All staff will be protected with screens or PPE will be used. Including Office, ice, bar and kitchen.

Socializing will be done at your assigned table in the upper lounge, please do not move the tables or chairs as we must maintain 2 meters of separation between all tables and chairs. We also ask that you do not gather in large groups in the parking lot, and wear masks when you are traveling around the building and to your vehicle.

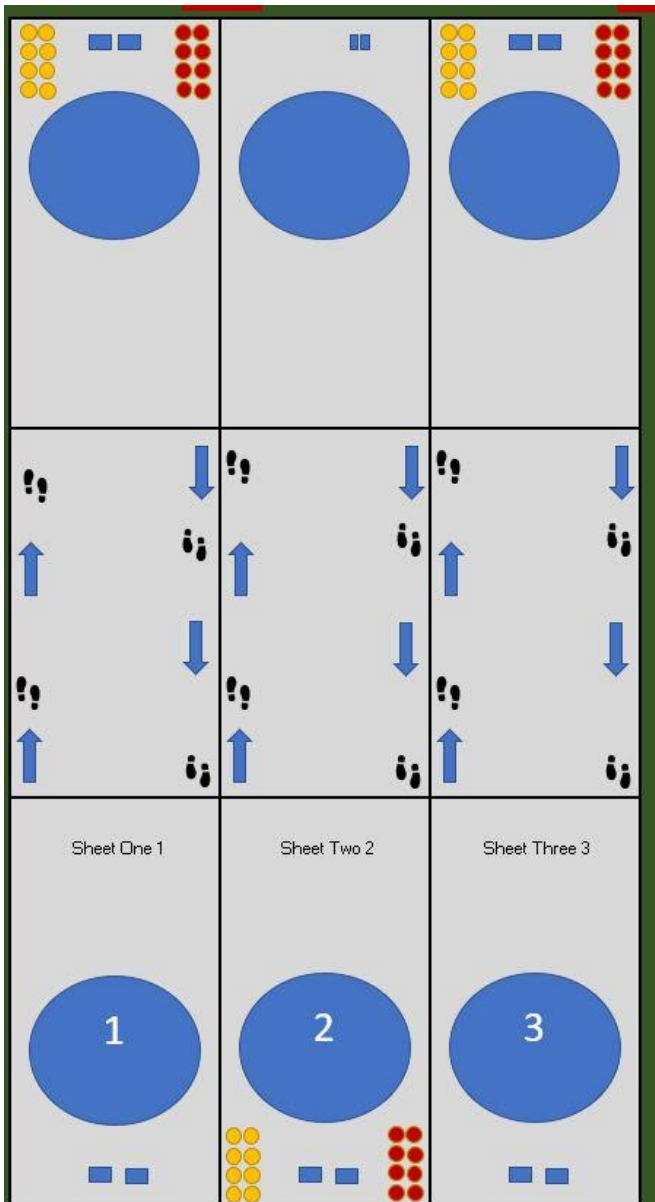
There will be no bar service, please go straight to your table in the upper lounge and wait for your server.

Members are expected to wash hands and/or use hand sanitizer when in the building, there will be multiple stations available.

Exit the building from downstairs at the left hand doors or from upper lounge doors behind sheets 1 or 12 straight out to the parking lot. Exceptions for elevator users only.

**The KCC would like to remind everyone that this is a community effort to keep our club and community safe at all time and operational for the entire season. We ask you to familiarize with all the rules and procedures in place before the beginning of the season and to remain continued in your efforts.**

## Rules of Play for Covid-19 Kelowna Curling Club

- Masks are requested while playing
- Please use paper, scissors, rock to determine hammer
- Rocks will have a template and sanitizer on them when you arrive, do not remove the template until the sanitizer has been on for at least one minute. At the end of the game return the rocks to same location and put template on.
- No handshakes please, elbow or foot bump
- Please do not use the scoreboard, paper and pencil will be provided if needed
- Odd numbered sheets will start and finish at the scoreboard end
- Only touch the rocks with your hands that you are throwing, do not touch others rocks except with broom or feet
- When measuring, please do the following. Remove gloves, sanitize hands, use measurer, return it to its station, then sanitize again
- Only one sweeper per stone, unless your teammate is in your 'bubble' then you may have 2 sweepers
- The Skip/Third in control of the house should **NOT** sweep in the house
- Practice ice will be scheduled, and you must book ahead

- Non-delivering team Skip/Third may not enter the house until the opposing teams skip/third relinquishes control. You may **NOT** sweep your opponent's stone behind the t-line. If a rock is swept accidentally, the non-offending team can place the rock back where they believe it would have ended.
- Non-delivering team locations. Skip stands on the back boards behind the hack at the playing end. Sweepers stand on each side of the sheet on the places marked between the hoglines, or at least 6 feet from the nearest player on surrounding sheets between the hoglines.
- Next to deliver may stand on the back boards to the right-hand side of the thrower at least 2 meters away, or between the hoglines
- Spots will be marked on the ice as suggested places to stand.
- There will be no water coolers on the ice or in the lounge, please fill you water bottle prior to arriving or at the filling station in the lobby.
- Curlers that are NOT registered members of the KCC may **NOT** spare.
